

# Metroparks Toledo | Toledo, Ohio Glass City Riverwalk By the Numbers

#### • 300 acres

Square footage of land connected through a five-mile multi-use trail

# • 200,000 visits

Times people visited the new Glass City Metropark (within the Glass City Riverwalk) in the first three months of operation, making it the most popular of the 19 Metroparks in Lucas County.

### • \$225 million initiative

More than \$167 million in funding has been secured thus far.

#### \$1 billion

Projected economic impact to the region resulting from the Glass City Riverwalk.

#### • 5 miles

The regional park system's expanded conservation efforts have resulted in a park within five miles of every home in the county.

### • 135,000

Hours of labor to build Phase 1 and 2 of Glass City Metropark.

# • 19,000

Labor hours to date on work funded by the \$23+ million 2020 BUILD Grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation.

# 69 collaborators

There were 69 trade partners and vendors that helped to complete Phase 2 of Glass City Metropark.

#### • 30,760

Cubic yards of dredge material from the muddy Maumee imported for planting and turf areas.

# Zero

Not one of the glulam beams used to build the ceiling structure of the 9,500 square-foot Market Hall is the same.

#### • 14 miles

Fourteen miles, or 74,000 linear feet, of tubing underneath The Ribbon supplies refrigerant to keep the surface cold for ice skaters throughout the winter season.

# • 10 years

The decade-long project began in 2020 and is scheduled to be completed in 2030.
